KUVEMPU University

Kuvempu University is a young affiliating University in Karnataka. Established in 1987, it is a University with a distinctive academic profile, blending in itself commitment to rural ethos and a modern spirit. It has 57 Post-Graduate departments of studies in the faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce, Education and Law. The University has 97 affiliated colleges, four constituent colleges (one of these is an autonomous college) and the other three autonomous colleges, three B.P.Ed. colleges, six Law colleges and 30 B.Ed. colleges under its jurisdiction spread over 3 districts of Shimoga, Chitradurga and Chikmagalur. Indeed, Kuvempu University is a place one would love to be associated with. The modern and well equipped building of the Library in Kuvempu University offers excellent infrastructure facilities in reading, borrowing and reference to the students, teachers and research scholars of all the departments. Over 69,011 volumes and 251 current periodicals are available. The library has kept pace with modernization by introducing a CD ROM data base, internet and e-mail facilities. It is also a nodal centre for INFLIBNET, thus having access to resource sharing. Bound back-volumes of journals are also available. The library has access to 2000 e-journals on line under the UGC-INFONET programme. The library has also been provided with excellent facilities for the self learning of the student beyond university hours.

The acronym LIS Academy stands for "Library & Information Science Academy". Like-minded library professionals established LIS Academy as a professional, Charitable Trust to work for the development of the Profession and to assist Libraries with the state-of-art technology and to honour the professionals with awards and recognition. The primary focus was to provide need-based service to the profession and to work for the advancement of Library and Information Science (LIS). The current focus of LIS Academy is to reach the unreached LIS professionals with rural settings to minimize the digital divide. It also aims at the working for the Public Libraries, the segment which almost remains as an area of neglect.
